20' walk from public parking at Schloss Waldegg 4532 Feldbrunnen/St.Niklaus (2 km northeast of Solothurn)

Erratic boulders were transported during the Last Glacial Maximum (ca 20'000-18'000 years before Present) to the Jura piedmont by the ice shield coming from the Swiss Alps and the Mont Blanc Massif. One such block is subject of the early photograph «Martinsfluh Erratic Boulder», 1978, by Daniel Schwartz; it was the departure point of his project «While the Fires Burn. A Glacier Odyssey» (2009-2016) and is to be seen in the exhibition «Zur Zeitlichkeit im Eis» at the Kunstmuseum Solothurn.
